

SOUTH WARREN REGIONAL POLICE COMMISSION

February 19, 2013

The meeting of the South Warren Regional Police Commission was called to order by Mayor Steinhardt at 9:00 am. The meeting was held at the Lopatcong Township Municipal Building located at 232 S. Third St., Phillipsburg, New Jersey. A silent prayer was offered followed by the Oath of Allegiance.

Mayor Steinhardt stated “adequate notice of this meeting has been provided indicating the time and place of this meeting in accordance with Chapter 231 of the Public Laws of 1975 by advertising a Notice in The Star Gazette and The Express-Times and by posting a copy on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building.”

Present: Mayor Steinhardt, Mayor Kern, Councilwomen McCabe and Van Lieu. Also present were Pohatcong Township Acting Chief of Police Greenemeir and CFO Dobes.

Old Business:

Minutes – Mayor Steinhardt asked for a motion to approve the minutes of February 5, 2013. Motion by Councilwoman Van Lieu, seconded by Councilwoman McCabe. Roll call vote:

Committee Updates -

Personnel Committee – Councilwoman Van Lieu had no report but will provide updated list of Pohatcong’s personnel so a new list can be provided to Civil Service.

Mayor Kern noted that Pohatcong’s Police Contract should be ratified at their Council Meeting so negotiations can move forward with both Township Police Departments. Also no report from the Finance Committee.

Mayor Steinhardt stated that he is working on setting up a meeting with the Shared Services Director Ms. Nancy Malool from the Department of Community Affairs and would like to have our representative from Civil Service attend. A tentative date of March 11th at 11:00 am is scheduled.

Administrative and Executive Committee – No updates. Website lists folders for minutes and meeting dates. Mayor Steinhardt reported that the DCA reviewed and commented on the Bylaws he sent down approximately a year ago. Mayor Steinhardt reported that he received copies of the

paperwork Camden County created for our reference as they are in the process of consolidating police services also.

Mayor Steinhardt asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion by Councilwoman Van Lieu, seconded by Councilwoman McCabe.
