

## **SOUTH WARREN REGIONAL POLICE COMMISSION**

**April 16, 2013**

The meeting of the South Warren Regional Police Commission was called to order by Mayor Steinhardt at 9:00 am. The meeting was held at the Lopatcong Township Municipal Building located at 232 S. Third St., Phillipsburg, New Jersey. A silent prayer was offered followed by the Oath of Allegiance.

**Collective Bargaining Committee** – Mayor Steinhardt along with Councilwoman McCabe will work up a plan before the next meeting in order to go over their recommendations before meeting with the representatives of both police departments.

**Administrative and Executive Committee** – Councilwoman Van Lieu stated that the by-laws would be completed as progression is made with the merger.
