

SOUTH WARREN REGIONAL POLICE COMMISSION

July 16, 2013

The meeting of the South Warren Regional Police Commission was called to order by Mayor Steinhardt at 9:00 am. The meeting was held at the Lopatcong Township Municipal Building located at 232 South Third Street, Phillipsburg, New Jersey. A silent prayer was offered followed by the Oath of Allegiance.

Administrative and Executive – Councilwoman McCabe would like to resurrect those questions that have been addressed to be able to place on the websites and the Township’s Facebook page.
