Herbicide Applications for The Township of Lopatcong County of Warren, State of New Jersey

In compliance with the NJAC7:30-9,10, notice is hereby given that Drake's Landscaping will be spraying herbicides, between the months of June 8th 2026 till September 30th 2026 for the purposes of grass and weed control.

There will be spraying for grass and weed control along curb lines, concrete or stone areas in detention basins, around signs, fence lines, under guard rails as well as various other locations within the municipality boundaries during normal business hours. The Herbicides being applied are Finale XL, Barricade 4FL.

Drake's Landscaping will be applying Lebanon 18-0-4 with Prodiamine 0.38% pre-emergent and Surge Broad leaf Herbicide on the lawn at the Municipal Building at 232 S 3rd St., Phillipsburg NJ 08865

All Product labels and SDS Sheets are on file at the Lopatcong Public Works Garage located at North Third and Beers St.

Herbicides will be applied by back pack sprayer out of skid mounted sprayer on a UTV or Stand on spreader/sprayer machines. At the request, the department of Public Works shall provide a resident with notification at least 12 hours prior to applications.
